



## HERE ARE SOME TIPS TO HAVING A STRESS FREE, FUN AND ORGANIZED HOLIDAY DECORATING EXPERIENCE!

- 8. Consider incorporating some DIY or handmade decorations to personalize your Christmas display.


  This could include homemade ornaments, handmade wreaths, or DIY advent calendars.


